AS OUR PRESIDENTIAL election came to an end on November 4, 2008, and political & racial party lines were drawn across the U.S., there was even more division in California where the highly publicized Proposition 8 was passed during the the state's general election ballot.

The Proposition aimed to eliminated the right for same sex couples to marry, and will be fiercely debated for another four years.

The future of marriage equality was discussed during a Townhall Meeting on Thursday, October 2nd at First Congregational Church of Oakland, CA and attempted to bring "dialogue and people together to work out issues in their communities with a special focus on the Black Church." said Rev. Roland

Stringfellow, the event's organizer and gay rights proponent. The activist hired filmmaker Nefertiti A. Strong to produce and direct the documentary For Faith, For Love, Forever.

"This documentary will dig down deep, past the politics, and focus on the people and the lives that are really affected by this proposition," Strong said. The young director's documentary will not only shed light onto a very important issue, but give people who did not attend the townhall meeting a chance to weigh in on the issues. "The beauty of film is you get to capture a moment in time forever, so that future generations can not only see what happened, but hopefully understand why you did something," Strong said.
